<sup>4</sup> All students are required to take the one-year program in one of the following components: (1) Military Training Service/ROTC; and (2) Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS)

<sup>5</sup> Sociology 180 (Social Statistics) may be taken in place of Social Science 103.

<sup>6</sup> Political Science elective should be taken in any three (3) areas of the disciplinal program (Philippine government and politics, political dynamics, comparative government and politics, international relations, and political theory and methodology).
